

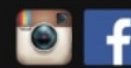

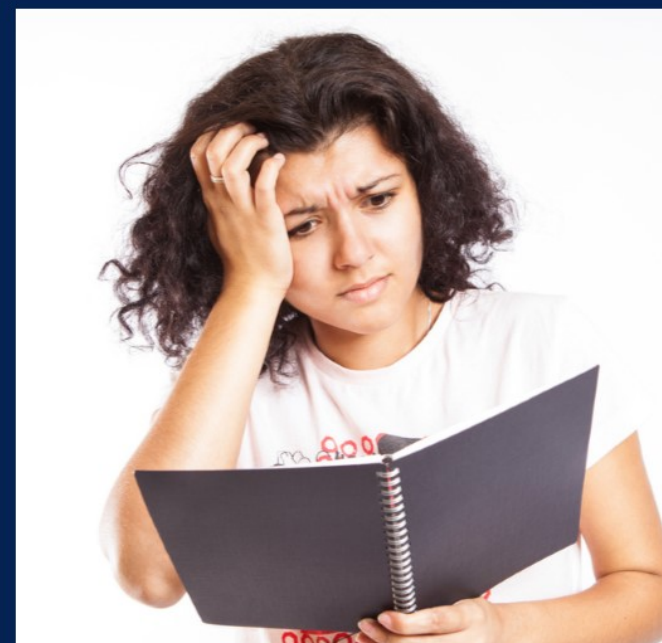

Not enough study spaces?

The first exam period always comes sooner than you would expect it, and there are never enough study spaces at the UvA. The FSR wants to help and has therefore together with the Faculty Board facilitated classrooms that can be used the whole day for studying during the exam week. The room numbers will be available on the big screens and on our facebook.



University quarter

The plans for the new University Quarter are becoming more and more concrete. The FSR FGW has and will continue to provide constant advice on how these are interpreted by the student population. The new University Library will be located in Binnengasthuis 5 (the old CREA building). These plans are already at a further stage. The education of the Faculty of Humanities will be concentrated around the Binnengasthuis premises and the OMHP, featuring underground bicycle parkings.

- The building where Vox-Pop is housed will probably be relocated.
- The upper floors of the buildings are used to absorb the growth of departments and to provide space for startups.
- Concerns were expressed about the amount of catering and especially its type (useless for most students).
- The Academic Club becomes a cafe in the plans. Next to BG2 there will be an extra bridge.
- A meeting place and a rooftop bar with a view of the Amstel will be built in the University Theater.
- The research department will be located in the OIH / Bushuis.
- PC Hoofthuis will be divested (sold).

Occupation PCH

Although the student council does not support the form of protest, we also believe that it is time for concrete steps to reduce work pressure, performance pressure and diversity. Moreover, we share the opinion that the quality of education must be first. We know that the cutbacks made on higher education are being made by The Hague. But the Faculty Student Council of Humanities, like the occupiers, finds that with the current budget there can also be enough changed at the faculty. We are pleased that the Executive Board has also indicated these matters and wants to take concrete steps as quickly as possible. We therefore hope to enter into a dialogue with both the Executive Board and the faculty Board on the short term discussing the follow-up steps.
